



Washington Complete Streets Leadership Academy

Eligibility requirements

The [Complete Streets Leadership Academy](#) is a technical assistance program designed to help jurisdictions identify and overcome barriers to implement Complete Streets. This Academy will support mid-sized communities who have already adopted Complete Streets ordinances. Eligibility criteria include:

- Jurisdiction is a municipality, county, or tribal government in Washington state
- Jurisdiction has previously adopted a Complete Streets ordinance
- Jurisdiction has an assessed value between \$600 Million and \$10 Billion
