Kansas City – EPA TA (Parking Audit) Six Month Progress Report June 14, 2017

Recommendation: Implement paid parking in the River Market district.

The City has solicited a parking meter demonstration in efforts to select a vendor to partner with for future on-street parking equipment options. Four vendors will participate in a 90 day demo. The first company will deploy equipment starting mid-July.

Recommendation: Develop a prototype enhanced enforcement system through a private contractor.

The City has budgeted for enhanced parking enforcement and has made a solicitation for a 3rd party vendor to provide parking enforcement services to include booting. Proposals for these services are due to the City on June 27th.

Recommendation: Develop a detailed, accurate database for River Market parking supply and utilization.

A survey of market attendees for the establishment of a benchmark profile for the River Market has been completed.

The City is in the process of requesting information from vendors to establish a budget for a parking data analytics platform. We plan to use the requested information to create a request for proposals. The City intends to receive the requested information by late July.

Recommendation: Develop a strategic communication program for River Market access and circulation.

We have used <u>kcmo.gov/publicworks/rivermarketparking</u> to keep stakeholders in the loop and will update that information accordingly. I will keep you abreast as we work through the items above.
